



Rent Rite Equipment Certificate of Insurance Requirements

In order to remove the damage waiver on a contract, customers may choose to provide a Certificate of Insurance (COI).

When an approved Certificate of Insurance is on file, it will remain on file until the expiration of the policy or until the customer requests removal. The customer is responsible for providing an updated Certificate at the end of the policy term. Failure to provide an updated Certificate will result in damage waiver being charged on contracts after the expiration date.

Minimum Requirements:

- Commercial General Liability insurance with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- Certificate of Insurance must be on file and approved by Rent Rite prior to the contract start date. Rent Rite will not retroactively remove the damage waiver from contracts opened prior to receiving an approved COI.
- Certificate of Insurance must have rental equipment coverage. Coverage must be equal to or greater than the replacement cost for all equipment on rent at one time (i.e. if multiple contracts are open, coverage must cover the equipment on all contracts).

The following info must be listed in the description portion of the Certificate of Insurance:

Rent Rite Equipment is listed as additional insured and loss payee with respect to rented equipment
